



## Central Indiana Chapter of the Association of Certified Fraud Examiners Scholarship Application

The purpose of the Central Indiana Chapter of the Association of Certified Fraud Examiners Scholarship Awards is to promote advancements in the fields of fraud prevention and detection by encouraging the education of potential future members of the fraud prevention and detection fields. Central Indiana Chapter ACFE Scholarships will be awarded to any Indiana student who receives a Ritchie-Jennings Memorial Scholarship from the Association of Certified Fraud Examiners, who applies for the Central Indiana Chapter ACFE Scholarship according to instructions on the chapter's website and who provides all information requested by the chapter. To the extent that funds are available, the Central Indiana Chapter ACFE Scholarship Fund will match scholarship amounts awarded by the Ritchie-Jennings Memorial Scholarship, dollar-for-dollar, up to \$2,500 for the same academic year for which the Ritchie-Jennings Memorial Scholarship is awarded.

### **Eligibility**

Any recipient of the Ritchie-Jennings Memorial Scholarship who is a resident of Indiana or will attend a school in Indiana for the academic year for which the Ritchie-Jennings Memorial Scholarship is awarded is eligible for the Central Indiana Chapter ACFE Scholarship. Residency in Indiana will be based upon the address provided on the student's Ritchie-Jennings Memorial Scholarship application and proof of residency provided.

### **Submission of Application Form**

The application form starting on page 2 is a fillable pdf file. Fill it out completely electronically, then "Save a Copy". Note that the application requires a signature. You may provide an electronic signature, or print out the completed application, sign it and either scan it as a pdf or print it. Email or mail the completed application to any officer of the chapter. For the statement of qualifications and education and career goals, you may use the page included in this application form, or attach a separate page.
